Louise McCarren Herring Scholarship to National Credit Union Foundation's Development Education Program

This professional development scholarship honors Louise McCarren Herring, an Ohio native and a pioneer of the U.S. Credit Union Movement. Herring organized more than 500 credit unions in Ohio, and managed several of them at various times. She was the first full-time managing director of the Ohio Credit Union League.

American Share Insurance funded the initial endowment for the Louise McCarren Herring Development Education (DE) Scholarship. The DE program brings renewed relevance to the phrase, "People Helping People." This intensive training program links credit unions' past with their present, explores the cooperative business model and social responsibility, and is an excellent opportunity for career development and personal enrichment.

This professional development grant covers the entire cost of tuition expenses, which includes room & board.
